Curriculum Information

English and Maths ~ We will be continuing our SATs revision programme which aims to prepare our pupils by raising their confidence and getting them familiar with the SATs-based questions and formats. Following SATs, English will be focussed on news reports, play scripts and detective narratives—all linked to our Crime and Punishment topic. In maths, we'll be applying our maths skills by carrying out some open-ended maths investigations centred around shape and space, statistics and measurement.

Science and DT ~ We will be looking at electricity and how to build and manipulate circuits using a wide range of components. We'll then be taking this knowledge to design some of our own anti-crime devices from electronic guillotines to pressure sensitive burglar alarms.

ICT ~ The children will have an opportunity to discover how stop motion animation works by creating their very own crime scenes.
