## GREAT KS2 SATs TEST RESULTS 2019

Last year's Y6 pupils achieved really good test results in 2019. These were as follows:-

**READING - 82% Achieved the Expected Standard or Better.**  
(National Average = 75%)

**WRITING - 91% Achieved the Expected Standard or Better.**  
(National Average = 78%)

**MATHS - 91% Achieved the Expected Standard or Better.**  
(National Average = 75%)

**GPS - 91% Achieved the Expected Standard or Better.**  
(National Average = 77%)

In the main measure which combines these results our children attained grades that were 15% above the national average.

**READING/WRITING/MATHEMATICS COMBINED - 79% Achieved the Expected Standard or Better.** (National Average = 64%)

As reported in our July Newsletter, 2019 outcomes in EYFS and KS1 were also well above national averages. These results confirm the high levels of academic achievement throughout the school.

Attainment in all subjects, not just the government tested ones, is good. Our FLiC data system records pupils' achievements across the whole curriculum and is used to produce the Pupil Reports.

## CHILD PROTECTION MATTERS
